SHRINE OF REMEMBRANCE MEDAL

2017 NOMINATIONS ARE NOW OPEN

Since 2008 the Shrine of Remembrance Medal recognises an individual or group that has made outstanding contributions to the advancement of community knowledge and understanding of the service and sacrifices made by Victorians for their country in times of war and peacekeeping.

The Shrine Trustees are pleased to invite nominations for the 2017 medal. The recipient will receive a unique bronze medallion, specially designed by renowned sculptor and medallist Michael Meszaros. The 2017 medal will be presented at an invitation only ceremony at the Shrine, following the Remembrance Day commemorative service at the Shrine on Saturday 11 November, 2017.

OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the Shrine of Remembrance Medal are to:

- promote the value and importance of remembering veteran's service and sacrifice;
- recognise achievements and individual accomplishments in the area; and,
- raise the profile of the Shrine's work as the pre-eminent agency in Victoria in promoting the community education of veteran's service and sacrifice.

CRITERIA

Nomination criteria includes innovative and inspiring contributions by an individual or group to educating the community about service and sacrifice in one or more of the following areas:

1. Research and/or publications, for example books or research papers published during the preceding 12 months;
2. Teaching and learning, for example developing new programs or outreach initiatives;
3. Commemorative activities, for example developing new and innovative forms of commemoration and/or sustained service to existing activities;
4. Community engagement, for example engaging new and existing audiences promoting lifelong learning, increasing access and participation; or,
5. Service to the Shrine of Remembrance, for example voluntary contribution to the work of the Shrine.

 2. There are no age restrictions in regard to the nominee(s).
 3. The completed nomination form must be returned to reach the Shrine of Remembrance no later than 5pm Friday, 6 October 2017. Nominations received after this date will not be accepted.
 4. Self-nominations will not be accepted.
 5. Please restrict your answers to the space provided on the Nomination Form.
 6. All submitted material becomes the property of the Shrine of Remembrance which reserves the right to use the information provided for subsequent promotion.
 7. The Medal will be presented at the Shrine following the Remembrance Day service on Saturday 11 November 2017. The nominee must be available to attend the presentation if shortlisted as a finalist.
 8. The decision of the Medal Committee is final. No correspondence will be entered into regarding entries.
 9. Current members of the Board of Trustees and staff of the Shrine of Remembrance are ineligible for nomination.
