## GUIDED PROGRAMS

### PRIMARY STUDENTS

#### **Welcome to the Shrine** (60 minutes, years Prep-4)

Journeying through the Shrine building and gardens, looking at statues, flags, medals and poppies, junior primary students discover why and how the community remembers and commemorates wartime experiences. **BOOK NOW.**

#### **On the Home Front** (60 minutes, years Prep-4)

Junior primary students learn about the history and meaning of the Shrine through exploring everyday life for the children of Melbourne during the Second World War. **BOOK NOW.**

#### **Shrine Exploration** (60 minutes, years 5-6)

On a tour of the Shrine's unique and beautiful memorial spaces, upper primary students learn about the impact of conflict on Australians across time. This tour can be customised to focus on a chosen theme. **BOOK NOW.**

#### **Keepsakes from the Great War** (90 minutes, years 5-6)

In this engaging hands-on program, upper primary students tour the Shrine and explore the impact of the First World War on Australians at home and overseas. **BOOK NOW.**

## **GUIDED PROGRAMS**

### **SECONDARY STUDENTS**

#### **Shrine Guided Introduction** (60 minutes, years 7-12)

On a tour of the Shrine's unique and beautiful memorial spaces, students learn about the reverberations of war for Australians across time. This tour can be customised to focus on a chosen theme. **BOOK NOW.**

#### **Victorians in the First World War** (90 minutes, years 7-12)

Handling iconic equipment and uniforms of the Great War, and touring the Shrine, students explore the everyday experiences and lasting effects of the conflict on Australians 100 years ago. **BOOK NOW.**

#### **The Second World War: Australian experiences** (90 minutes, years 9-12)

Students handle a diverse range of authentic artefacts and memorabilia from the Second World War and explore the rich stories displayed in the Galleries of Remembrance, all within a tour of the Shrine's spaces of commemoration. **BOOK NOW.**

#### **Only 19: Australians in the Vietnam War** (90 minutes, years 7-12)

Students discover the Shrine and learn about Australian involvement in the war in Vietnam. Where possible this program is led by volunteer Shrine guides who are also Vietnam veterans. **BOOK NOW.**
