Tuesday 24 January	Induction	Introduction to the Shrine and the role of a Young Ambassador.
Wednesday 5 April	Legacy Students Day	91st Anzac Commemoration for students. Assist with ceremonial duties and visitor engagement.
Tuesday 11 - Friday 21 April	School holiday program	Assist with delivering of our school holiday program. Programs run weekdays during the school holidays excluding public holidays from 11am – 2pm.
Tuesday 25 April	Anzac Day	Assist with visitor engagement.
Wednesday 31 May	Victorian Aboriginal Remembrance Service	Participate in a commemoration honouring the service and sacrifice of Aboriginal people.
Tuesday 27 June	The cost of war	Hear from guest speakers with firsthand experience of conflict.
Monday 26 June - Friday 7 July	School Holiday Program	Assist with delivering of our school holiday program. Programs run weekdays during the school holidays excluding public holidays from 11am – 2pm.
Wednesday 6 September	Battle for Australia Day Commemoration	Participate in a commemoration honouring the service and sacrifice of those who defended Australian shores from attack in the Second World War.
Tuesday 12 September	Interstate trip	Day trip interstate to learn about commemoration in other places.

Tuesday 19 September	Leading a commemoration	Session on how to plan and run a commemoration.
Monday 18 – Friday 29 September	School holiday program	Assist with delivering of our school holiday program. Programs run weekdays during the school holidays excluding public holidays from 11am – 2pm.
Saturday 11 November	Remembrance Day	Assist with ceremonial duties and visitor engagement.
Saturday 2 December	Young Ambassador Wreath Laying Service	Lead commemoration for Shrine community, Young Ambassadors, and families.
ONGOING	ACTIVITY	NOTES
Various Sundays	Last Post Ceremony	This 15-minute service takes place every Sunday at 4:45pm and includes bugle calls and piper, Shrine Guard in historic uniform, a wreath-laying, recital of the Ode, and lowering of the flags. Each service commemorates a different event from Australia's military history. You should attend at least one of the ceremonies over the course of the year.
Additional	Occasional duties and opportunities as they arise	For example: Promoting the mission of the Shrine within your school community.
